## MEALS

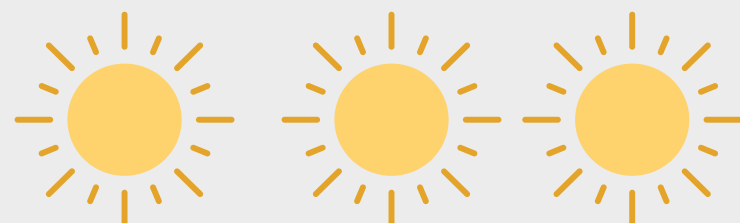
